
Nodau heddiw

Aims of today


- ▶ To engage with businesses to explore ways to reduce their greenhouse gas emissions and energy costs.

We aim to:

- ▶ Encourage interaction with businesses, higher and further education, and with public and private sector stakeholders
- ▶ Identify key themes and sectors, and priorities for investment.
- ▶ Support business led innovation, enterprise and investment in Mid Wales.
- ▶ Secure wider collaborative and transformational working with key partners organisations and the business community
- ▶ Agree roles, responsibilities and improved delivery arrangements in the promotion of economic development.
- ▶ Ensure broad input and engagement that will help advise on the Growth Deal

- ▶ Strategy (Vision for Growing Mid Wales) - sets out 8 key strategic growth priorities/themes.
- ▶ Each theme has its own strategic aims (identified from engagement and consultation) e.g. labour market development, supporting market growth, direct intervention.
- ▶ It provides the wider strategy (and aligns with Welsh Gov's Regional Economic Framework).





- ▶ Dywedodd 40% o fusnesau eu bod wedi cynllunio prosiectau datgarboneiddio / ynni
- ▶ Roedd mwyafrif y busnesau hynny yng nghyfnodau cynnar cynllunio eu prosiectau
- ▶ Mae rhai busnesau'n arloesol iawn

What have businesses got planned?

- ▶ 40% businesses said they had decarbonisation / energy projects planned
- ▶ Most of those businesses were in the early stages of project planning
- ▶ Some very innovative businesses





Key challenges

- ▶ **Understanding of net zero**
- ▶ **Decarbonisation advice**
 - ▶ “Often too generic”
 - ▶ “Very little useful advice for micro businesses”
 - ▶ “I don’t know who to approach”
- ▶ **Financial support**
 - ▶ “Very difficult to reduce our greenhouse gases anymore without financial support from government”
- ▶ **Skills gap**
- ▶ **Energy infrastructure**
